

Training Process to Become an LCC

1. After being admitted as an LCC (Leader Competence Center) candidate, at least **5 candidate exercises** must be completed during breed surveys and evaluations, involving a **minimum of 30 dogs**.
The **LAZ** (Dr. Helmut Raiser, GSD & Mathias Dögel LAZ BSD) may reduce the number of required exercises based on the candidate's previous experience as a judge.
2. The evaluation and approval of the exercises are carried out by the **LAZ RSVglobal**.
3. After successfully completing the candidate exercises, the LCC candidate must complete a **final evaluation**.
This final evaluation can only be conducted at the **LAZ RSVglobal**, in the presence of and in agreement with the majority of the board.
4. The final evaluation includes both a **practical and a theoretical part**.
5. The entire training process, up to and including the final evaluation, must be completed within a **maximum of 3 years**.

Recognition as an LCC

1. After passing the final evaluation, the **appointment as LCC** is made by the **LAZ RSVglobal**.
2. The appointment is published on the official website of the Schäferhundverein RSV2000 e.V. and becomes **effective upon publication**.
3. The appointment as LCC is valid for **5 years**.
Further appointments for an additional 5 years may be granted by the board.
